






## Resurrection Preschool and Toddler Crafts

**Safety Tips:** Keep scissors and craft knives out of reach of children. Keep all glue caps, marker caps and other small items out of reach of children age 3 or under, as they are a choking hazard. Use nontoxic washable markers. Watch young children when they are using crayons, to be sure they don't put them in their mouths. Have an emergency plan in place in case of injury, ie. First Aid procedures

	<p>Sad Women craft page Spices (Tomb Acces. page) Cardstock Scissors (grown-up only) Crayons Extra-strength glue sticks or School glue Restickable glue sticks</p>	<p><b>Women/Spice Stickers</b> – Age 2+ <u>Prep:</u> Print picture and make copies onto cardstock. <u>Craft:</u> Children color picture. Cut out spices. Place restickable glue on the backs of the spice jars. Allow to dry. Have children stick on the women's hands when it says in the lesson. You can also use a craft knife to cut across women's hand/s to have a place to insert spice jar stickers, and use regular glue to glue picture on top of a blank sheet (everywhere except the hands that you'll lift up to insert stickers).</p>
	<p>Standup Tomb Accessories pages (3) Angel/Wings pages Heavy Cardstock Scissors (adult only) Craft knife (adult only) Glue sticks Crayons Clear tape</p> <p><u>Words/Sun/Butterfly:</u> Tape words, sun, butterfly to background wall or hang.</p>	<p><b>Standup Tomb</b> – Age 2+. <u>Prep:</u> Print craft pages. Make copies onto cardstock. Cut out all pictures. (If using the color-illustrated pictures, choose one tomb and stone). <u>Craft:</u> Children color pictures. <u>Tomb:</u> Cut slits on the sides of the entrance long enough to slide head/feet of mummy behind slits. <u>Stand:</u> Overlap the two pieces of the stand and glue together. Glue stand to back of tomb. <u>Angel/Wings:</u> Cut out, fold back tabs on dashed lines. Place glue on middle section. Glue to back of angel. <u>Tomb/Angel/Flowers:</u> To stand pieces with tabs, fold tabs back on dashed line.</p>
	<p>Spring Miracles craft pages Copy paper Crayons Scissors (adult only) Stapler / staples</p>	<p><b>Spring Miracles Booklet</b> – Age 2+. <u>Prep:</u> Print and make copies of craft pages. Cut apart booklet pages. Collate and staple booklets together. <u>Craft:</u> Children color pages.</p>

	<p>Candy Cross craft page            Cardstock            Flower Lollipops            Scissors (adult only)            Craft knife (adult only)            Crayons</p> <p>For <u>Option 2</u>            One of the following:            Colored copy paper            Wood grain scrapbook paper            Construction paper</p>	<p><b>Candy Cross – Age 2+.</b> <u>Prep</u> for Option 1: Print Candy Cross page. Make copies onto card stock. <u>Option 2:</u> Cut out one of the cardstock cross pictures as a pattern: Lay on one of the types of paper, trace and cut out new colored crosses (for children to glue on top of white craft page). <u>Craft:</u> Children color cross and flowers. Put names on the back of children’s pictures. Take pictures in another room and carefully use craft knife to cut slits on cross. Keep knife out of reach of children. Insert lollipop down into the first slit, to go under picture, and up through the second slit (lower one), so that the top and bottom of the lollipop show on the craft.</p>
	<p>Kids/Hearts craft page            Cross (on Angel wings page from Resurrection Standups PDF file)            Small shapes cut from brown or black construction paper            Restickable or repositionable glue sticks            Cotton balls (optional)            Regular glue sticks</p>	<p><b>Kids/Hearts Craft – Age 2+.</b> <u>Prep:</u> Print and make copies of craft pages. Cut out cross. <u>Craft:</u> Children color craft page. Pull apart cotton balls and glue to clouds. Place restickable glue on the back of the cross. Allow to dry before sticking.</p>
