




Safety Tips: Keep scissors out of reach of children. Keep all glue caps, marker caps and other small items out of reach of children age 3 or under, as they are a choking hazard. Use nontoxic washable markers. Watch young children when they are using crayons, to be sure they don't put them in their mouths. Have an emergency plan in place in case of injury, ie. First Aid procedures

 <p>Option 1: Stickers page Restickable, regular glue</p>	<p>Touch-n-feel craft page Cardstock Copy paper Scissors (adult only) Crayons Envelopes Option 2: Craft patterns page Fabric scraps (optional) Wood texture paper Colored copy paper Regular glue Option 3: Real crackers Marshmallow cream</p>	<p>Road to Emmaus Touch-n-Feel Craft – Age 2+. Prep: Print pages. Make copies of craft page onto cardstock, and stickers onto copy paper. Option 1: Stickers – Cut out bw or color stickers for kids. Place in envelopes. Craft: Kids color bw stickers, or use color-illustrated stickers. Apply glue to back of stickers. Stick to craft page. Option 2: Patterns/Textures – Cut patterns out, lay on fabric or wood textured paper, trace and cut out new shapes. Kids color craft page and apply texture stickers with restickable glue and regular glue (table). Option 3: Kids “glue” real crackers or cookie pieces on the plates using marshmallow cream as the “glue”.</p>

Color-illustrated Puzzles: Prep: Print and make copies of puzzles and templates onto cardstock. Print and make a copy of the picture for kids to see what it's supposed to look like. Place restickable glue on back of puzzles. Allow to dry. Cut off edges, and cut apart puzzle pieces. Place pieces for each puzzle in an envelope. Activity: Give each child a template and puzzle pieces. Show them how the pieces fit together on the template. Black-and-white puzzles: Craft: Child colors pages before you apply glue on back and cut apart.</p>

(The photo reflects the old Standups, not the ones with the hearts).</p>	<p>Boy and Girl Standups God and Sin Standups Flower stickers page Heavy cardstock Blank sheet of 11 X 17 construction paper, copy paper, or butcher paper Scissors (for adult) Restickable glue sticks Crayons</p> <p>See Activities for how to make Paper Plate Sun for Visual Aid.</p>	<p>Boy or Girl Standup Craft – Age 4+. Prep: Standups: Print girl and boy standups. Make copies onto heavy card stock. Cut out Standups and stickers for children. For <u>visual aid</u>, make road out of butcher paper. (The one in the photo is 2-1/2 ft). Craft: Children color boy or girl, stickers. Show kids how to fold back tabs to stand. Show kids how to draw a curvy road on the sheet of paper, and place the God sign on one end, and the Sin sign on the other side. Color road and grass. Apply restickable glue to backs of flowers, heart. Add flower stickers to road. Show children how to make sin marks on heart, then put the new heart on after the kids are forgiven.</p>
