

Safety Tips: Keep scissors out of reach of children. Keep all glue caps, marker caps and other small items out of reach of children age 3 or under, as they are a choking hazard. Use nontoxic washable markers. Watch young children when they are using crayons, to be sure they don't put them in their mouths. Have an emergency plan in place in case of injury, ie. First Aid procedures

Make copies onto white or colored paper. Cut copy paper into rectangles (about 8" wide, and the length of your butterfly's body (for tube).</p>	<p>Craft: Children color butterfly. Help children roll rectangles into tubes (big enough to fit their hands through) and tape closed. Tape tube onto the back of the butterfly, aligning with the middle of the body. How to Use: Children insert hand or a few fingers and move up and down to "fly" it and how to fold wings back behind it's body to insert into cocoon.</p>

For Classroom Activity: Print color-illustrated ones or color bw ones Print templates (optional). Copy both onto cardstock or copy paper. Cut puzzles apart. Keep pieces to each puzzle in a separate envelope. How to Use: Show children how to fit pieces together on template. Talk to children about butterflies as they work. Craft: Cut the puzzles apart after children color them. (Keep scissors out of reach of children).</p>

	<p>Cross craft page Cutouts/Stickers Cardstock, copy paper (colors) or construction paper Scissors (adult only) Regular glue sticks or restickable glue Optional: 9 X 11" sheets of construction paper</p>	<p>3D Cross and Kids – Age 2+. Prep: Print craft pages. Make copies of Stickers onto copy paper. Make copies of cross onto colored card stock or copy paper. Or cut out one Cardstock cross and use as a pattern: Lay on construction paper, trace and cut out. (Tip: You can cut more than one layer at a time if you staple a few layers of construction paper together first). Craft: Children color stickers. Cut out stickers for kids. (Keep scissors out of reach). Show kids how to fold up petals of flowers and butterfly wings to give it a pop-up 3D effect. Children place restickable glue stick glue on the back of stickers (but not the wings or petals that are folded up). Allow restickable glue to dry before sticking on cross. For age 4+, Give kids a 9 X 11" sheet of construction paper to glue cross and "New Life" words on. (Not pictured).</p>

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
