 Washable Red Kids’ paint and paint supplies or crayons.  
 Extra clothing (See Activities)  
 Passover meal with wrapped bread in bags (See Activities)  
 Cardboard staffs (See Activities)  
 Cloaks: Shirts with sleeves (See Activities)  
 Egyptian costumes (For assistants)

 Pharaoh (Week 1)  
 Doorframe Craft (Ready to paint)

**Prep:** Make all the craft samples. Have assistants help the children prepare for their Passover meal and pretend to be Egyptians. (See Activities)

**Key Verse:** Psalm 105:42-43. **Other Verses used in lesson:** Exodus 12:11; Deut.7:9; Psalm 105:2,37. **Lesson based on verses:** Exodus 11:1 – 12:42, 50, 51; Deut. 7:7-9; Num. 33:3-4.

Lesson Snapshot – Week 6 Lesson, Crafts, Activities (See Crafts and Activities for details)	
<b>Help Me Feel Welcome Warm-up Activity</b>	<b>God Helps the Israelites Leave Egypt!</b>
Greet children as they arrive. Children learn the difference between bread made with yeast and bread made none. Set up alternative activities.	Children hear the Egyptians crying, but learn that the angel passed over their house. They get gold and silver from the Egyptians!
<b>Intro: Review of Plagues Bible Story</b>	<b>Group Activity: Exodus Parade</b>
Review the first nine plagues.	Children march confidently around the room.
<b>God Helps the Israelites Get Ready!</b>	<b>Let’s Rhyme: Free at Last!</b>
The children paint the doorframe and put the Passover food stickers on the plate.	Children do the actions and listen to a rhyme about how God kept his promise.
<b>Let’s Pretend to be the Israelites!</b>	<b>Let me Share Talk Time</b>
Children get ready for the last plague with their staffs and their cloaks tucked into their belts.	Children get a chance to answer questions about the story as you explain how God keeps his promises now, just like he did then.
<b>Let’s Rhyme! – Get Ready for Passover</b>	<b>Let Me Pray Prayer Time</b>
Children hear the rhymes and do the actions to prepare for the Passover.	Teacher prays about the concepts of the lesson. Children can also take turns to pray.
<b>Pretend Passover Snack</b>	<b>Make My Own Craft Time/Take-Home Craft</b>
Children eat their pretend Passover snack. Refer to Activity page for snack ideas.	Gold/Silver Israelite Craft, My Ten Plagues Booklet, Passover Kids.
